### **Tunnel between J&K, Ladakh to be ready by June' 21**

Work on the 6.5km Z-Morh tunnel, part of a strategic project for ensuring round the year connectivity between Kashmir Valley and Ladakh region, is being under taken on a war footing and it will be completed by June 2021, an official spokesman said here Monday.

The spokesman said the information about the status of works on the Z-Morh tunnel was given at a meeting chaired by Jammu and Kashmir Chief Secretary, B V R Subrahmanyam. The chief secretary took the meeting of national Highway Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) to review the progress of various road projects being undertaken by them in Jammu and Kashmir.

With regard to Kashmir province, the meeting was informed that works on mega projects including Z-Morh tunnel and Zoji-La tunnel, are being undertaken on a war footing, the spokesman said.

“During the meeting, it was given out that Z-Morh tunnel project comprises 6.5 km tunnel, a 6.0 km approach road, two major bridges and one minor bridge. The project worth ₹2,379 crore is expected to be completed by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 and will provide round-the-year connectivity to Sonamarg,” he said. Work under Zoji-La project is also being taken up simultaneously. This project includes a 14.15 km tunnel, an 18 km approach road between Z-Morh and Zoji-La tunnel as a single integrated package, besides carriageway and 18 avalanche-protection dams.

### **Rail line connecting Tanakpur with Bageshwar to cost ₹6,966 crore**

The much-awaited 154Km long railway line connecting Tanakpur with Bageshwar will cost ₹6.966 crore, an official said.

Railway authorities have prepared an updated survey report of the project and sent it to the railway board for further action.

“An updated survey report about the proposed Tanakpur-Bageshwar railway line has been prepared by the railway ministry. It has been sent to the board of railway for further action,” said Rajendra Singh, public relation officer of divisional railway manager officer, Izzatnager, Bareilly.

People of Kumaon have been demanding the railway line over the years as they hope that the railway service would not only facilitate better transport facilities but also help in developing the remote areas of the region.

Tanakpur is the last railway head in Kumaon where the railway line was laid in 1911-12 by the Britishers to transport timber and other minerals from this area.

A survey for the railway line was conducted in 2006-07 and an updated survey was carried out in 2019.

VK Tripathi, general manager, north-eastern railway, Gorakhpur, while talking about the updated survey during a visit to Kathgodam on Tuesday said the railway line will have 154-158Km long track with 72 tunnels and more than 170 large and small bridges on the way.

“It will have 13 stations – Tanakpur, Purnagiri, Pancheshwar, Kakrighat, Nayal, Salyur, Bageshwar among others. The cumulative length of the tunnels will be 53.44 km,” he said.

DeenDayal Agarwal, a trader from Tanakpur, said, “Railway service will not only be beneficial for the Kumaon region but also for the people of western Nepal.

“Since, the line will be laid near the international border, people of western Nepal will also have a chance to avail the benefit. It will also boost pilgrimage as well as tourism in this region.”

Naveen Deopa, a social activist from Champawat, said, “the railway line will help in the development of the remote areas where the line will be laid.

“It will help fruit and vegetable growers to have transport facility to ferry their produce.”

## **Work on Mumbai coastal road starts in January 2021**

Work on the coastal road tunnel in Mumbai will start in Jan 2021. A 12.9m diameter slurry TBM of Chinese manufacturer CRCHI will be used to bore the 1.9km long bored section of the 3km twin tunnel between Nariman Point and BandraWorli. The remaining sections will be completed with cut-and-cover excavation.

The twin tunnels will become part of the 10.6km first phase of the coastal road. It would take project developers Brihan Mumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) 18 months to complete the tunnels. The first phase will run from GirgaumChowpatty to the Bandra-Worli Sea Link. Despite the Covid-19 lockdown, BMC has managed to complete 17% of work on this section so far. Work is delayed but expected to be completed by July 2023.

The entire Mumbai coastal road is an 8-lane 29.2km long freeway that will run along the western coastline of Mumbai, connecting Marine Lines in the south to Kandivali in the north. It is projected to be used by 130,000 vehicles daily and is expected to reduce travel between South Mumbai and the Western Suburbs from 2 hours to 40 minutes.

## **TBM breakthrough at Pune metro**

The Maharashtra Metro Rail Corporation (Maha-Metro) has achieved another breakthrough as the a Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) completed 1.6 km underground tunnel digging between Agriculture College and Shivajinagar on No. 7, 2020. The TBM started its journey at Agricultural College in Nov. 2019.

This was one of two TBMs being used for tunnelling this twin bored underground section, which will become part of the 16.6km Line 1. In September 2020, the first TBM had successfully excavated the other tube.

In 2018 and 2019 both packages for the underground sections of Line 1 – from Agricultural College to Swargate – were awarded to a joint venture comprising of Tata Projects and Guelmark. The second package includes a 5.1km underground section.

## **Mumbai-Ahmedabad high speed rail corridor contract**

The National High Speed Rail Corporation Limited (NHSRCL) of India on Nov. 26 signed an agreement for the design and construction of 237km of the 508km Mumbai-Ahmedabad high speed rail corridor.

The contract signed with Larsen & Toubro contains the entire alignment between Vapi and Vadodara. This section will have four stations, 14 river crossings, 42 road crossings and six railway crossings including one 350m long mountain tunnel. The duration for completion of the works is four years.

“During the construction phase of this section, the areas around the alignment will witness social and economic development,” NHSRCL stated. “There will be employment generation and a boost in the demand of construction material and machinery. Ancillary industries like hospitality, entertainment, health, tourism, and housing will also flourish during the construction.

## **India’s membership of the UN Security Council**

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday said he is “deeply grateful” for the overwhelming support shown by the global community for India’s membership of the UN Security Council. India will work with all member countries to promote global peace, security, resilience and equity, he said.

India garnered 184 votes out of the 192 ballots cast in the General Assembly to win the election for the no-permanent seat in the powerful Security Council. India’s two-year term will begin on January 1, 2021. This is the eighth time that India will sit at the UN high-table, which comprises five permanent members and 10 non-permanent members. “Deeply grateful for the overwhelming support shown by the global community for India’s membership of the UN Security Council,” the prime minister wrote on Twitter. India will work with all member countries to promote global peace, security, resilience and equity, he added.

Union home minister Amit Shah, too, expressed his gratitude on Twitter. “Gratitude to the member nations for unanimously supporting India’s membership to the UN Security Council. Under the strong and visionary leadership of PM Narendra Modi, India will uphold its mantra of ‘VasudhaivaKutumbakam’ and will work towards peace and prosperity of the world,” he tweeted.

In a statement hours after the election results, the ministry of external affairs described the commitment to a reformed multilateral system, which reflects India’s long-running ambition and demand for a permanent seat on the council, which has been described by India and countries with shared objectives, as a body completely out of sync with changes global realities.

## **Vardhan takes over as WHO executive board head**

Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan, who is at the forefront of India's battle against COVID-19 pandemic, took charge as the chairman of the 34-member WHO Executive Board on Friday, officials said.

Vardhan, who succeeded Dr Hiroki Nakatani from Japan, offered his condolences at the loss of lives due to the coronavirus pandemic across the globe.

In his remarks after being elected as the chairman of the WHO executive board, he also said a strengthening of global partnerships and a shared response was needed to deal with the current crisis caused by the pandemic. The proposal to appoint India's nominee to the executive board was signed by the 194-nation World Health Assembly on Tuesday.

Last year, WHO's South-East Asia group had unanimously decided to elect India's nominee to the executive board for a three-year-term beginning May.

The chairman's post is held by rotation for one year among regional groups and it was decided last year that India's nominee would be the Executive Board chairman for the first year starting Friday.

The Executive Board comprises 34 individuals, technically qualified in the field of health, each one designated by a member-state elected to do so by the World Health Assembly. Member States are elected for three-year terms.

The board meets at least twice a year and the main meeting is normally in January, with a second shorter meeting in May, immediately after the Health Assembly.

The main functions of the executive board are to give effect to the decisions and policies of the Health Assembly, to advise it and generally to facilitate its work.

Addressing the 73<sup>rd</sup> World Health Assembly via video conferencing on Monday, Vardhan had said India took all necessary steps well in time to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

## **Behind vaccine, a couple's passion to beat cancer**

Positive data on BioNTech and US partner Pfizer Inc's Covid-19 vaccine is unlikely success for the married couple behind the German biotech firm, who have devoted their lives to harnessing the immune system against cancer.

Pfizer on Monday said its experimental vaccine was more than 90% effective in preventing Covid-19 based on initial data from a large study.

From humble roots as the son of a Turkish immigrant working at a Ford factory in Cologne, BioNTech chief executive Ugur Sahin, 55, now figure among the 100 richest Germans, together with his wife and fellow board member Oezlem Tuercü, 53, according to weekly *Welt am Sonntag*. The market value of Nasdaq-listed BioNTech, which the pair co-founded, ballooned to \$21 billion as of Friday's close from \$4.6 billion a year ago, with the firm set to play a major role in mass immunization against the coronavirus. "Despite his achievements, he never changed from being incredibly humble and personable," said Matthias Kromayer, board member of venture capital firm MIG AG, whose funds have backed BioNTech since its inception in 2008.

He added Sahin would typically walk into business meetings wearing jeans and carrying his signature bicycle helmet and backpack with him.

Doggedly pursuing his childhood dream of studying medicine and becoming a physician, Sahin worked at teaching hospitals in Cologne and the southwestern city of Homburg, where he met Tuereci during his early academic career.

Medical research and oncology became a shared passion. Tuereci, the daughter of a Turkish physician who had migrated to Germany, said in a media interview that even on the day of their wedding, both made time for lab work.

Together they honed in on the immune system as a potential ally in the fight against cancer and tried to address the unique genetic makeup of each tumour.

Founded in 2008, BioNTech pursued a much broader range of cancer immunotherapy tools. That included mRNA, a versatile messenger substance to send genetic instructions into cells.

The BioNTech story took a twist when Sahin in January came across a scientific paper on a new coronavirus outbreak in the Chinese city of Wuhan and it struck him how small the step was from anti-cancer mRNA drugs to mRNA-based viral vaccines.

BioNTech quickly assigned about 500 staff to project to work at “light speed” on several possible compounds, winning pharma giant Pfizer and Chinese drug-maker Fosun as partners in March.

## **PM at Bloomberg (Metro) Event**

\$30-billion worth of projects on building a 100 smart cities. Modi said.

The New Economy Forum is organized by Bloomberg Media Group, a division of Bloomberg LP, the parent company of Bloomberg News.

While 31% of India’s 1.3 billion people currently live in cities, migration from rural areas in search of jobs has strained already creaky public amenities, posing challenges for policy makers. Investments in urban infrastructure can help shore up Asia’s third-largest economy which has slipped into an unprecedented recession after its covid lockdown, according to a Reserve Bank of India (RBI) report.

To address the growing urbanization, Modi’s government has introduced programs to build houses for poor, improve infrastructure, boost public transport and provide clean drinking water. The initiatives have also brought investment opportunities and need for new technology.

India is planning an affordable rental housing initiative as part of its post-Covid rebuilding, the prime minister said, and will also complete construction of 10 million urban homes in the next couple of years. Around 1,000 kilometers of railway lines that are part of project to build suburban train systems in 27 cities is also expected to be completed before 2022, he said.

“If you are looking to invest in urbanization, India has exciting opportunities for you,” Modi said.

## **India's 2018 tiger census creates Guinness record**

India's 2018 tiger census has entered the Guinness Book of World Records for being the world's largest camera trap wildlife survey. For the survey, camera traps were placed at 26,838 locations across 141 different sites.

Following the citation, a Union environment ministry statement on Saturday called India's tiger conservation efforts a "gold standard" for the world.

Environment minister Prakash Javadekar tweeted, "The All India Tiger Estimation is now in the Guinness World Records for being the largest camera trap wildlife survey, a great moment indeed and a shining example of Aatmanirbhar Bharat." He added that India fulfilled its target of doubling tiger numbers four years in advance of its promised 2022 deadline.

The 2018 All India Tiger estimation had found 2967 tigers in the country, compared to 2,226 in 2014. The minister also shared an image of the World Record citation on his official Twitter handle. "The fourth iteration of the survey – conducted in 2018-19 was the most comprehensive to date, in terms of both resource and data amassed. Camera traps (outdoor photographic devices fitted with motion sensors that start recording when an animal passes by) were placed in 26,838 locations across 141 different sites and surveyed an effective area of 121,337 km<sup>2</sup>(46,848 square miles). In total, the camera traps captured 34,858,623 photographs of wildlife (76,651 of which were tigers and 51,777 were leopards)...," the citation read.

## **Goldman sees \$16 tn scope for investing in renewables**

Spending on renewable power is set to overtake oil and gas drilling for the first time next year as clean energy affords a \$16 trillion investment opportunity through 2030, according to Goldman Sachs Group Inc.

Renewables including biofuels will account for about a quarter of all energy spending next year, up from about 15% in 2014, Goldman analysts including Michele Della Vigna said in a June 16 note. This is in part driven by diverging costs of capital, as borrowing rates have risen to as high as 20% for hydrocarbon projects compared with as little as 3% for clean energy.

Clean energy could drive \$1-\$2 trillion a year in infrastructure investment and create 15-20 million jobs globally.

Meanwhile the high cost of capital for fossil fuel developments is leading to underinvestment, which could lead to higher oil and gas prices that in turn spur a faster energy transition.

"Renewable power will become the largest area of spending in the energy industry in 2021, on our estimates, surpassing upstream oil and gas for the first time in history," Goldman said in the note. The divergence in borrowing costs for high and low carbon developments implies a carbon emissions price of about \$40 to \$80 a tonne, Goldman said.

In the real world, however, only about 16% of global emissions are priced, and the average value is about \$3 a tonne.

That's creating a bifurcated investment model, with money flowing into mature technologies including wind, solar and biofuels while less-developed efforts such as like carbon capture and clean hydrogen could suffer without higher emissions prices, Goldman said.

"A two-speed de-carbonization process may therefore accelerate de-carbonization in the short term, but ultimately delay the long-term path towards net zero," Goldman said in the note.

## **RIL net debt-free after ₹1.69 lakh crore fund raise**

Billionaire Mukesh Ambani on Friday announced that his oil-to-telecom conglomerate Reliance Industries is now net debt-free after raising a record ₹1.69 lakh crore from global investors and a rights issue in under two months.

Reliance raised ₹1.15 lakh crore from global tech investors by selling a little less than a quarter of the firm's digital arm, Jio Platforms Ltd, and another ₹53,124.20 crore through a rights issue in the past 58 days.

Taken together with last year's sale of 49% stake in fuel retailing venture to BP Plc of UK for ₹7,000 crore, the total fund raised is in excess of ₹1.75 lakh crore, the company said in a statement.

Reliance had a net debt of ₹1,61,035 crores as on March 31, 2020. "With these investments, RIL has become net debt-free," it said.

"I have fulfilled my promise to the shareholders by making Reliance net debt-free much before our original schedule of March 31, 2021," RIL chairman Mukesh Ambani said.

Jio Platforms – which houses the country's youngest but largest telecom firm Reliance Jio, raised ₹1,15,693.95 crore from leading global investors including Facebook, Silver Lake, Vistic, KKR, Mubadala, ADIA, TPG, L Catterton and PIF since April 22, 2020.

Saudi Arabian sovereign wealth fund PIF buying 2.32% stake in the unit for ₹11,367 crore on June 18 "marks the end of Jio Platforms' current phase of induction of financial partners," the statement said.

Alongside, Reliance launched India's biggest right issue, which was subscribed 1.59 times.

Though the rights issue size was ₹53,124 crore, the company has got only 25% of the money as the remaining is to be paid only next fiscal.

Ambani had at the company's annual general meeting on August 12, 2019 announced a roadmap for Reliance to become a net debt-free company before March 31, 2021.

"We have a very clear roadmap to becoming a zero net-debt company within the next 18 months that is by March 31, 2021," he had said last year high-lighting strong interest from strategic and financial investors in consumer businesses, Jio and Reliance Retail.

In the statement on Friday, he said he was both delighted and humbled to announce the fulfillment of the promise.

“Exceeding the expectations of our shareholders and all other stakeholders, again and yet again, is in the very DNA of Reliance,” he said.

“Therefore, on the proud occasion of becoming a net debt-free company, I wish to assure them that Reliance in its Golden Decade will set even more ambitious growth goals, and achieve them,” he added.

He said over the past few weeks, phenomenal interest was received from the global financial investor community in partnering with Jio.

“As our fundraising milestone from financial investors is achieved, we sincerely thank the marquee group of financial partners and warmly welcome them into Jio Platforms,” he said.

“I also express my heartfelt gratitude to all the retail and institutional investors, both domestic and foreign, for their overwhelming participation in our record-setting Rights Issue,” he added.
